ITINERARY

Day 1 Thursday, April 20 – Depart Philadelphia for overnight flight to Amsterdam.

Day 2 Friday, April 21 – Amsterdam, Zaanse Schans, Edam, and Volendam

Upon arrival, proceed through customs and collect baggage. A Jet Vacations guide will greet you and take you on a scenic journey to several villages, including Zaanse Schans, a pretty historical village on the Zaan River. There are well preserved windmills some dating to the 17th century and an open-air museum. Continue to Edam and enjoy a walking tour. Travel to Volendam to spend the afternoon before traveling back to Amsterdam for a short walking tour around the hotel and Welcome Dinner near the hotel. (Dinner)

Day 3 Saturday, April 22 – Amsterdam: Canal Tour and Rijksmuseum

Enjoy a full day tour of Amsterdam beginning with boat tour along the city's UNESCO canals past picturesque gabled houses, bridges, and churches. After lunch at a local restaurant, visit the recently renovated Rijksmuseum, the national museum dedicated to the arts and history of the Netherlands. The museum contains a collection of over one million pieces. There are over 8,000 displays in 80 galleries, including Vermeer's Milkmaid and Rembrandt's Night Watch. Return to the hotel for a free evening. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 4 Sunday, April 23 – Delft, The Hague, and Mauritshuis Museum

Travel to Delft, the home of Vermeer. Visit the Delft Pottery Factory to learn how the blue-and-white Delft pottery is made. Then explore the city center to see the Waag (Weigh House), Oude Kerk (Old Church), and Nieuwe Kerk (New Church). Enjoy free time for lunch in Delft. In the afternoon travel to The Hague, the government center of the Netherlands and the world's judicial capital. Stop to see the Peace Palace and continue on to the Mauritshuis Museum, home to the best Golden Age Dutch paintings, including Vermeer's Girl with a Pearl Earring, Rembrandt's The Anatomy Lesson of Dr. Nicolaes Tulp, Fabritius's The Goldfinch, and Potter's The Bull. Return to the hotel for a free evening. (Breakfast)

Day 5 Monday, April 24 – Teylers Museum in Haarlem and Van Gogh Museum in Amsterdam

Travel to Haarlem to visit the Teylers Museum, an art, natural history, and science museum and then enjoy free time for lunch before traveling back to Amsterdam to visit the Van Gogh Museum to see works of art that influenced Vincent Van Gogh as well the largest collection of works by the artist, including his paintings, drawings, and letters. Return to the hotel for a free evening. (Breakfast)

Day 6 Tuesday, April 25 – Keukenhof Gardens and Amsterdam

Travel to the Keukenhof Gardens, one of the world's largest flower gardens which covers 79 acres with spring flowers and of course its lovely tulips. Enjoy free time for lunch and then return to Amsterdam for a free afternoon and evening. (Breakfast)

Day 7 Wednesday, April 26 – Gouda and Utrecht

Travel to Gouda, the historic city in the province of South Holland, known for its cheese, candles, and waffles of stroopwafels. During the tour of the city enjoy a cheese tasting at a local cheese shop and stroopwafels at a local waffle bakery followed by lunch. After lunch continue to Utrecht, a city in central Netherlands and a religious center. It has a medieval town center, canals, Christian monuments, and a university. The Domtoren, a 14th century bell tower, stands opposite the Gothic Cathedral of St. Martin on the century square. Enjoy a guided tour and free time. Return to the hotel for a free evening. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 8 Thursday, April 27 – Amsterdam and King's Day Festivities

Today is a day free to enjoy the city-wide King's Day Festivities in honor of the birthday of the Dutch king, Willem Alexander. Before his mother, Queen Beatrix, abdicated in 2013 it was known as Queen's Day. Experience the city filled with orange-clad revelers. Return to the hotel for the Farewell Dinner. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 9 Friday, April 28 – After breakfast, depart for home or continue on to Bruges on the Post-Trip.

(Breakfast)

3 NIGHT OPTIONAL PRE-TRIP: LONDON (April 17 to April 20, 2023)

Day 1 Monday, April 17 – Depart the U.S. for overnight flight to London.

Day 2 Tuesday, April 18 – London

Upon arrival, proceed through customs and collect baggage. A Jet Vacations guide will greet you. Enjoy a walking tour around the hotel and at night the Welcome Dinner at or near the hotel. (Dinner)

Day 3 Wednesday, April 19 – London Tour and Pub Lunch

Enjoy a panoramic tour of London with several photo stops at the most famous London sights, including Westminster Abbey, Big Ben, Whitehall, Trafalgar Square, Leicester Square, London Bridge, and more. Then enjoy a traditional pub lunch. Enjoy a free afternoon and evening. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 4 Thursday, April 20 – London or Optional Half Day Tour to Windsor Castle

Enjoy a free day in London or an optional half day tour to Windsor Castle. Learn about English royal history on the way to the castle where you will see the State Apartments and St. George's Chapel where 10 English kings, including Henry VIII, are buried. Enjoy free time to visit the town of Windsor before returning to London for a free afternoon and Farewell Dinner at or near the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 5 Friday, April 21 – London/Amsterdam

After breakfast transfer to the airport for flight to Amsterdam. (Breakfast)

3 NIGHT OPTIONAL POST-TRIP: BRUGES - BELGIUM (April 28 to May 1, 2023)

Day 9 Friday, April 28 – Amsterdam, Antwerp, Ghent, and Bruges

Travel to Antwerp and enjoy a walking tour, including a tour of the Cathedral of our Lady. Enjoy some free time and lunch in Antwerp. After lunch travel to Ghent, the home of the Van Eyck brothers. Visit the Belfry and Town Hall, St. Nicholas's Church, the Mason's Guild Hall, and the Graslei. Next visit the medieval Gravensteen Castle and the Patershol neighborhood. Explore Ghent's trading history at the Great Butcher's Hall, the Old Fish Market, and the Friday Market. Finally visit the Cathedral of Saint Bavo. Travel on to Bruges, a UNESCO city which retains its village character in its historic center. It is known as the Venice of the North because of the many picturesque canals that are lined with medieval buildings. Enjoy the Welcome Dinner at or near the hotel in Bruges. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 10 Saturday, April 29 – Bruges

Take a walking tour by the tranquil waters of the famous Minnewater or the Lake of Love. Then visit Our Lady's Church to see Michelangelo's magnificent 16th century marble statue Madonna of Bruges, the only one of his works to leave Italy during his lifetime. Continue to the Market Square with its grand Belfry and the beautiful Town Hall Square and the ornate façade of the Basilica of the Holy Blood which was built in the 12th century as the residence of the Count of Flanders. It houses a vial believed to contain the blood of Christ the count brought back from the Holy Land. After the walking tour, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon and evening have free time to explore the city. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 11 Sunday, April 30 - Bruges/Brussels

Enjoy a morning exploring the importance of chocolate and beer to the city with visits to the Chocolate Museum to see the art of praline making and sample the sweets. Next visit a local brewery for a beer tasting followed by lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon take a boat ride on the lovely canals of Bruges which circle the city following the historic fortifications of the city. The canals once played a vital role in the transportation of goods, but today only tourist boats ply the canals. After the canal tour travel to Brussels for your last night in Belgium and the Farewell Dinner at or near your hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 12 Monday, May 1 – Brussels/USA

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport for flight to USA. (Breakfast)

Passenger Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial service fee/deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 150 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients may be non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non-changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation-change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.)
Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial non-refundable service fee / deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced & calculated as follows:
 -30 days after reservation: A service fee of \$300 becomes non-refundable.
 - Initial service fee/deposit**: non-refundable up to 150 days prior departure.
 From 150 to 91 days prior departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 90 to 61 days prior departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.
 From 60 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.
 If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.
Itinerary variation: We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised.
